### Registration and shipping fees

Please include the following amount, depending on where you live and the weight of the ornaments you're sending:

NS and PE: Include \$12 for each 1.5 lbs of ornaments

NB, QE, ON and NL: Include \$14 for each 1.5 lbs of ornaments

AB, MB, SK, and BC: Include \$17 for each 1.5 lbs of ornaments

US swappers: Include \$12 for each 1.5 lbs of ornaments (yes, it really is cheaper to send to the US than western Canada. Go figure.)

If you're outside of Canada and the US, please contact us ahead of time so we can calculate postage rates.

Cheques or money orders **in CAD** should be made out to **Janet Dawson**, not CBFA!

### Late items

If your items arrive late after the swap's been made, we will try to swap them with any other late items. If there aren't any, what would you like us to do? (check one)

- Return them to you
- Save them to use as CBFA prizes for future exchanges or events.
- Donate them to a local charity
